



Windmill Craft

John 3:8 "The wind blows where it wishes and you hear the sound of it, but do not know where it comes from and where it is going; so is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

What you need:

- Paper
- Pencil with eraser on the end
- Drawing pin
- Scissors
- Ruler



- Cut a 15cm square piece of paper.
- Draw two diagonal lines on the paper that cross at the centre and mark the centre point.
- Cut along each diagonal line, 7cm towards the centre of the paper. Decorate your windmill.
- Using the straight pin, punch a hole in the centre of the paper and at every other point (about 1/4" from the tip.)
- Curl each pierced point, in turn, toward the centre and poke the pin through the holes and through the centre.
- Attach the pin to the side of the eraser and you have your windmill.
