Rainbow in a bag (Adult help will be needed)

You will need:

- 1 cup flour
- 2 cups water
- tablespoon of salt
- Food colourings
- Ziplock bag/cardboard/tape



1. Whisk the flour, water and salt in a pan and cook over a low heat (continually whisking) until a smooth substance starts to form.
2. Put a tablespoon of mixture into 7 bowls to make your rainbow colours. Add food colouring to each mixture. Don't worry if you don't have 7 colours.
3. Trim the card to fit in your ziplock bag.
4. Add a heaped teaspoon of paint into the ziplock by holding the plastic away so you don't get paint on the bag yet.
5. Once you have all your colours in the bag (side by side) close the bag and fold over the top.
6. Tape down the edge of the bag and it's ready to use. Children can push around the paint to create a rainbow on the cardboard canvas.
