## Cheerio bird feeders

### What you need:

Pipecleaners (younger children)  
Florist wire (older children)  
Cheerios

### To make a heart or circle

Thread cheerios on a piece of wire or pipecleaner leaving about 2cm on each end.

Twist the ends together to form a circle, ensuring that the cheerios are not loose but tight to the ends of the wire.

Shape into a heart.

Tie string or wool through the heart shape to hang on a tree.

### To make a spiral

Make a loop at the end of the wire/pipecleaner to ensure the cheerios do not fall off.  
Fill the wire/pipecleaner up with cheerios leaving approx. 3cms at the top to make a loop.

Bend the wire around a cardboard tube to make a spiral shape.

Thread string or wool through the loop to hang on a tree.
