

<u>Marble maze</u> <u>You will need:</u> An old shoe box lid or a paper plate Coloured paper Straws Glue marble

- 1. Line the shoe box lid with coloured paper (this step is optional)
- 2. Cut a marble sized hole in the two opposing ends of the box and in opposite corners.
- 3. With a pencil draw out a path of where you would like the straws to go to create your maze. Make it as tricky as you want.
- 4. Cut out lengths of straw and glue to the paper/lid to create the maze shape.
- 5. There you have you own marble maze run.
