

Paper rainbows

You will need:

Coloured paper in the rainbow colours Cotton wool or white paper

Stapler

Scissors



- 1. Take seven sheets of coloured paper and arrange them in rainbow order.
- 1. Cut into strips of equal width (ours were about 2cm)
- 2. Trim the strips so that each is around 2cm shorter than the next.
- 3. Staple the ends.
- 4. Cover the staples with cotton wool (or white paper) clouds.
- 5. Hang as a garland or mobile decoration by threading cotton through the rainbow and securing.
