Windchimes

You will need:

Plastic cup

String or plastic lacing (5 x 8 inch strands) Variety of beads

- Use a pointy object (such as the end of a pair of scissors or even a pen) to poke a small hole in the bottom of the cup and four evenly spaced holes about 1cm down from the edge of the cup.
- 2. Next, slide one end of each string through the four holes around the edge and knot them.
- 3. Thread a selection of beads on each string.
- 4. Once each strand is complete, tie a knot in the ends.
- 5. Make a loop with the remaining string and push the two ends inside the cup from the hole you made in the bottom and tie in a knot.
- 6. If you like more sound, thread small bells onto the strands with the beads.
