Salt Dough Rainbow Fish

You will need:

- 2 cups of flour
- 1 cup of salt
- 1 cup of water, lukewarm

Food colouring


Sequins/beads/gems/googly eye



- 1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl.
- 2. Slowly add the water, continuing to stir until all is blended well.
- 3. Add the food colouring and knead the dough for at least 5 mins until the colour is evenly mixed.
- 4. Roll out the dough and cut out fish shapes. If you want to hang the fish up, poke a small hole through the dough at the top for hanging thread.
- 5. Decorate the fish with sequins, beads, gems and a googly eye.
- 6. Leave to air dry.


Jesus Feeds 5,000
