Falling leaves autumnal jar

You will need:

- Small glass jar and lid
- Brown pipecleaners
- Leaf shaped sequins



1. Take a brown pipe cleaner and fold it in half, then twist the ends together.
2. Trim the pipe cleaner so that it is the same height as the jar, then untwist the ends slightly and fold out to create a base.
3. Wrap another pipe cleaner around this one, and fold the end out at the bottom, then trim it to the same length as the other two ends. This will provide a firmer base.
4. Take another brown pipe cleaner and cut it in half. Wrap it around the tree to create a branch. Repeat this until you have about three branches on your tree.
5. Glue the bottom of the tree to the inside of the jar lid.
6. Fill the jar with water leaving approx. 2cm at the top and add some leaf sequins to the water.
7. Put the lid onto the jar, pushing the tree inside the jar. Then glue the lid in place.
8. Shake the jar and then watch the leaves fall.
