Bubble wrap tree

You will need:

Red, yellow, green & brown paint

Paper

Bubble wrap

Paintbrush



1. Use brown paint to paint a tree trunk with branches.
2. Cut the bubble wrap into 4 small squares.
3. Mix some red & yellow paint together to make orange and paint this onto the bumpy side of one of the bubble wrap squares.
4. Print the bubble wrap onto the tip of several of the tree branches and some on the bottom of the paper to create leaves on the ground.
5. Repeat this with red, yellow & green paint on the other 3 squares of bubble wrap until your tree is full of leaves.
