## Night Light Lanterns

### You will need:

- Small boxes - e.g. lightbulbs or food packaging
- Marker or pencil
- Craft knife
- Cellophane or clear plastic
- White glue
- LED lights
- Paint



1. Carefully pull the box apart, so it is still in one piece, but will lie flat.
2. Draw your designs onto the inside of the box, as the paint covers better.
3. Cut your designs with the craft knife and paint the surface of the box.
4. Cut cellophane to cover the cut out spaces and glue to the inside of the box.
5. Bend the existing folds of the box the opposite way than they were intended, so your box will keep its shape. Glue the side edges together. Fold the ends of the box back in.
