#### Peace dove

You will need: White card White paper Scissors Felt tip pen



- 1. Cut out the body shape of the dove (template is on page 2 of newsletter) and decorate with felt tip pen.
- 2. Lie the white paper flat in front of you. Fold over a piece about ½ inch wide. Turn the paper over and fold again. Keep going until all paper is folded.
- 3. Cut a slit in the centre of the dove and slide the folded paper half way through. Fold the top edges of the folded paper up to join one another and glue together.
- 4. If you want to hang the dove punch a hole at the top of the wings and tie through a length of thread.

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
