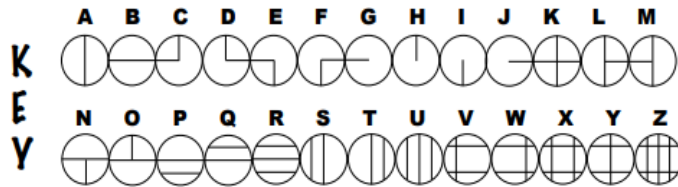

Window Star

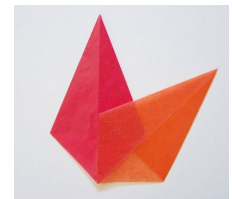
You will need

8 x 3" square sheets of coloured tissue paper

Glue



1. Fold each square in half to make a triangle. then fold in the sides to the centre line to form a diamond shape.
2. Overlap half of the top of the kite shapes together, up to the central fold and glue in place (see picture).
3. Continue until all 8 triangles have been glued to form a star shape.
4. Attach the star to your window or hang up using string, allowing light to shine through them.
