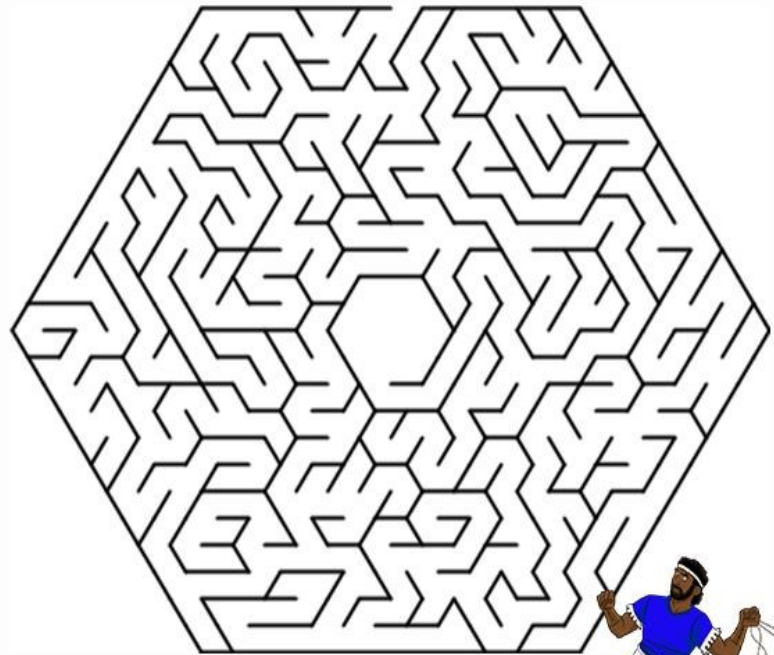

### Snowflake Art

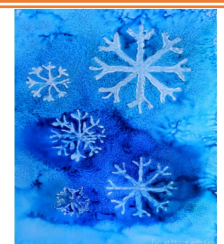
#### You will need

Sheet of white paper

White wax crayon or candle

Blue watercolour paints

Salt



1. Draw your snowflake design onto your paper using the wax crayon or candle.
2. Paint over your design using watercolour paint (you can use more than 1 shade of blue if you want to). The paint will fill in the paper around the snowflakes.
3. If you would like to create a pattern on the paint, lightly sprinkle salt over the wet paint. If your paint has already dried just dampen with a paintbrush dipped in water.
4. Leave to dry.

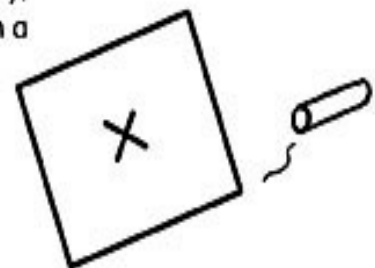

## Game

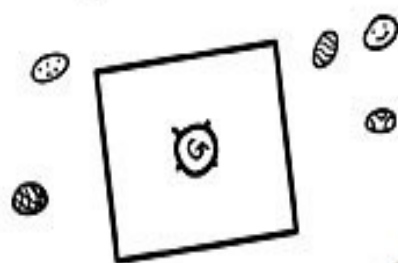
1. Have each player select five small, flat rocks and decorate using acrylic paint. The biggest rock is "Goliath".



2. While the painted rocks dry, draw a square with chalk on a sidewalk with an "X" in the center.



3. Each player takes a turn sliding their rock into the square. The first to knock "Goliath" out of the square wins.



\*Note: Be sure to "slide" your rocks and not "throw" to prevent injuries.

1 big flat rock



acrylic paint



paint brush

chalk



paper towels  
and water
