Cloud in a jar

You will need

Food coloring
Water
A clear jar
Shaving cream



1. Mix a few drops of food colouring into some water (this is the rain).
2. Fill your jar 3/4's full with clear water.
3. Fill the rest of the jar with shaving cream to make a cloud.
4. Using a pipette or syringe drop your coloured water on top of the cloud.
5. After a few minutes the drops of water will work their way through the cloud into the clear water below which resembles rain as it falls.
