Rev. Kath and Yoyo will be running a holiday club from about 9.30-12.30 each day 21st -25th July in Holtby

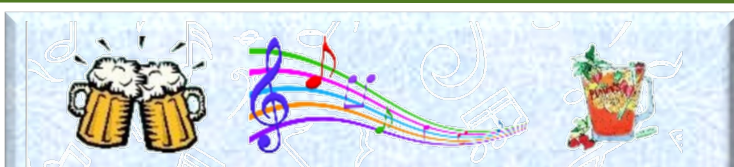
