and stay or join us to hear Mary talk about her time working with Archbishops.

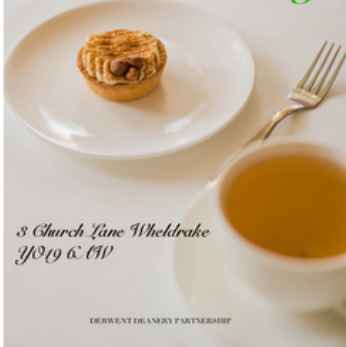
